

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Between
DIXIE SCHOOL DISTRICT
at Vallecito, Mary Silveira and Dixie Elementary Schools
and
BAY AREA COMMUNITY RESOURCES

INTENT

It is the purpose of this MOU to specify the agreement between Bay Area Community Resources (BACR) and the Dixie School District for the purpose of providing school based services at Dixie, Vallecito and Mary Silveira Elementary Schools for the 2019-20 school year.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. BACR will provide a .4 FTE school based service coordinator to provide counseling, case management, crisis intervention, and consultation to students, school staff and parents for two days per week at Mary Silveira Elementary School. Services will start the week of August 19, 2019 and end the week of June 8, 2020.
2. BACR will provide a .4 FTE school based service coordinator to provide counseling, case management, crisis intervention, and consultation to students, school staff and parents for two days per week at Dixie Elementary School. Services will start the week of August 19, 2019 and end the week of June 8, 2020.
3. BACR will provide a .6 FTE school based service coordinator to provide counseling, case management, crisis intervention, and consultation to students, school staff and parents for three days per week at Vallecito Elementary School. Services will start the week of August 19, 2019 and end the week of June 8, 2020.
4. BACR will provide 5 counseling interns to provide individual and group counseling services and clinical consultation to the Dixie District elementary schools. Two interns will be placed at Mary Silveira Elementary and Vallecito Elementary Schools and one at Dixie Elementary. Whenever possible these interns will be supervised by the school based service coordinator as part of his/her assigned hours at each of the sites. Intern counseling services will start the week of September 9, 2019 and end the week of June 1, 2020.
5. All BACR school-based counselors, coordinators, enrichment and tutoring staff will spend between 20% and 30% of their time towards activities that build stronger relationships with the school and increase their ability to affect change. These activities include, but are not limited to, attending SST and IEP meetings, crisis intervention, working short-term with disruptive kids, membership in planning, screening and development groups, offering supervision, training and support to school and community persons and classroom outreach/presentations.
6. BACR will provide technical assistance to any efforts by the Dixie School District in relation to substance abuse and student safety issues. BACR is committed to work at a school and District level in designing and implementing effective prevention programs that deter students from engaging in high-risk behaviors.

PROVISIONS:

- BACR will be the sole employer of the individuals selected for program participation in the Dixie School District. BACR will be solely responsible for paying staff salaries, salary related costs and benefits, if any. BACR will maintain worker's compensation insurance for each of its employees as required by law.
- BACR shall provide written assurance upon request to the Dixie School District that each of its employees has been fingerprinted and cleared such clearance, has been provided child abuse reporting training and has been tested for Tuberculosis.
- The Dixie School DISTRICT shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless BACR against and from any and all claims or suits for damages or injury arising from DISTRICT's performance of this Agreement or from any activity, work, or thing done, permitted, or suffered by the BACR in conjunction with the performance of this Agreement, and shall further indemnify, defend, and hold harmless BACR against and from all claims or suits arising from any breach or default of any performance of any obligation of DISTRICT hereunder, and against and from all costs, attorney's fees, expenses, and liabilities related to any claim or any action or proceeding brought within the scope of this indemnification.
- The BACR shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Dixie DISTRICT against and from any and all claims or suits for damages or injury arising from BACR's performance of this Agreement or from any activity, work, or thing done, permitted, or suffered by the DISTRICT in conjunction with the performance of this Agreement, and shall further indemnify, defend, and hold harmless DISTRICT against and from all claims or suits arising from any breach or default of any performance of any obligation of BACR hereunder, and against and from all costs, attorney's fees, expenses, and liabilities related to any claim or any action or proceeding brought within the scope of this indemnification.

PAYMENT for SERVICES:

The total amount due BACR for the above services is \$146,855.00.

The undersigned agree to the terms and conditions of this agreement.

Payable is due BACR in two payments. One half of this amount is due September 13, 2019. The remainder is due March 1, 2020.
